4. Construction Defect Law.

The Chair asks for comments regarding the proposal to add Construction Defect law as a specialty. All agree their questions were answered in the previous meeting and are satisfied with

5. Criminal Law Standards. Elizabeth Ortiz and Michael Goldberg reporting.

Elizabeth explains her background as a prosecutor since 1993, having worked both pre- and post- conviction. Michael also previously worked as a prosecutor. They outline the topic:

- 1) Currently experience in both appellate and felony trials is required in the Criminal Law standards, although usually attorneys do not work in both. They are distinct areas.
- 2) The purpose of legal specialization is to give consumers a guide, and the current measuring standard does not.
- 3) A discussion was held with Steve Weiss, Chair of the Criminal Law Advisory Commission who was a prosecutor and then defense attorney. He is no longer certified as a specialist, and he thinks pre- and post- trial work is normal, but only spoke for himself and not the Commission.
- 4) The question remains, is it appropriate to create a separate Appellate specialty?

Ideas were discussed including possible solutions: Adjusting the current standards to incorporate a point system; essays in their particular area of focus; allowing the specialist to indicate they do not work in a particular area (examples could be "Zoning" for real estate and "Appellate" for criminal law); or the development of sub-specialties.

Elizabeth and Michael will follow up with the entire Criminal Law Advisory Commission to address the topic.
